6. <u>THAMES VALLEY POLICE</u>

6.1 <u>Woodley Neighbourhood Action Group</u>

Councillors noted that the Bulmershe & Whitegates Borough Ward, which included the Town Whitegates Ward, was policed from Woodley rather than Earley. Consequently there has been a proposal to set up a Woodley & North Earley Neighbourhood Action Group which it was hoped would work closely with both Earley & Woodley Town Councils.

It was anticipated that there would be an initial meeting during the week commencing 12th June and that Whitegates Town Councillors had been informed. It was

<u>RESOLVED</u> that the Committee Chairman ask Councillor Mrs A Swaddle to represent Earley Town Council at the inaugural meeting and report to the next Council Meeting.

6.2 <u>Speed Indicator Device</u>

Councillors noted that further to Minute 54 where a request for funding towards a speed indication device (SID) was agreed in principle, the Town Clerk had contacted the Area Inspector who had responded as follows:

"We will not be guaranteeing that the SID will be available for a certain amount of days in specific parishes. Instead I believe the Community Speed Watch Scheme will deploy the equipment to where there are complaints of speeding from members of the community or to areas where they have already identified that speed reduction work is required.

In Earley the neighbourhood team have previously completed speed reduction work with a SID in Rushey Way, Ryhill Way, Carshalton Way and Meldreth Way. However the use would not be limited to these locations.

The frequency of use will depend on the amount of volunteers available to deploy the equipment. However early indications suggest there is a growing pool of potential volunteers to allow the equipment to be deployed several times a week. Where it is deployed will again depend on where the complaints are coming from.

I hope that helps. If you require any further information please let me know"

Councillors considered whether the Council should still proceed with contributing to the SID and it was

<u>RESOLVED</u> that the Town Clerk request further information on how the roads within Earley will fit into the picture of use across the Borough.
