Wokingham Borough Council has been working to implement its 2010 vision to facilitate the growth and regeneration of Wokingham through four strategic development locations. These major developments will accommodate a total of about 10,000 new homes, as well as new schools, shopping and community facilities, see <http://www.wokingham.gov.uk/major-developments/overview-of-major-developments/>. Part of these major developments will be the Wokingham Major Highways Programme – the construction of nine vital road schemes in Wokingham, as well as four strategic development roads providing access to the new homes. These new roads will alleviate congestion, enhance accessibility and deliver the infrastructure required to support the successful future of Wokingham Borough.

Balfour Beatty is working on behalf of Wokingham Borough Council on the Wokingham Major Highways Programme. The contract has been awarded under Scape Group's National Civil Engineering and Infrastructure framework.

The development locations that are part of the Wokingham Major Highways Programme are:

- **Arborfield Cross Relief Road**
- **Barkham Bridge Improvements**
- **Winnersh Relief Road:**
 - Winnersh Relief Road Phase 2
 - Lower Earley Way Dualling
- **South Wokingham Distributor Road:**
 - Eastern Gateway
 - Spine Road
 - Western Gateway
- **North Wokingham Distributor Road:**
 - West of Old Forest Road
 - Toutley Road
 - Ashridge Farm
