Important information about this course

Entry requirements for the course

Eligibility - To access this course You need to live within the Wokingham Borough, be over 19 years old (as of 31st August 2021) and been a citizen of a country within the EEA and have ordinarily been resident in the EEA for at least 3 years. Also, If you are an EEA National, you need to have obtained either pre-settled or settled status under the EU Settlement Scheme.

Hong Kong British National (Overseas) visa holders in the UK, are eligible if you meet the published residency eligibility criteria **including the 3 years ordinary residency requirement**. [See details here](#).

(There are a number of exemptions including those for some for asylum seekers or refugees.)
